


To our wonderful Parents and Caregivers,

Book: James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl

Ms. Howells says: "I have always loved Roald Dahl stories as it reminds me of my childhood when I read his stories for the first time. "James and the Giant Peach" fosters imagination and creativity through its strange and magical story. It explores friendship and belonging as James forms friendships with anthropomorphic insects, teaching resilience and the importance of overcoming adversity. The humour in the word choice and characters makes it entertaining and fun to read. Although there are small illustrations, the real magic lies in using your imagination to visualize the characters during their big adventure."

News from the PTA




Dear Parents.
