

What is ESF Hub?

ESF Hub is our new one-stop shop learning and student management system.

It is both an App and a web-based portal. When you access Hub, you can carry out lots of tasks such as reporting absence, reading messages from the school and accessing reports and assessments.

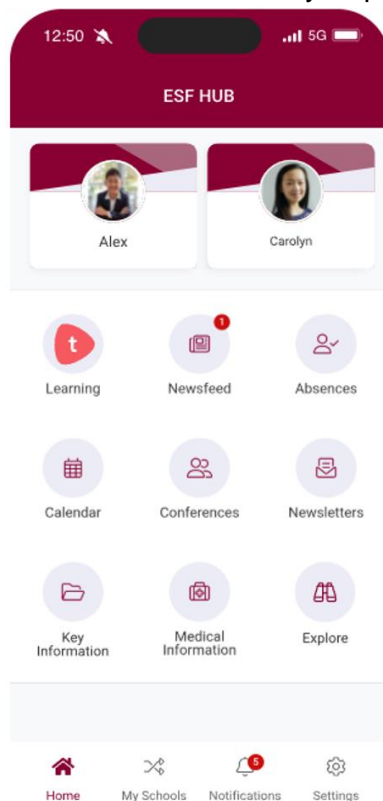
However, that is just the beginning.

For the first time, you will be able to access the same learning platform as your child: being able to see what they are working on, how they are progressing and even commenting on their work.

Let's break this down into two sections: the student management side and the learning platform.

ESF Hub: Student Management and Information

The ESF Hub homepage on both the App and the Web Portal will immediately present you with the most commonly requested information.



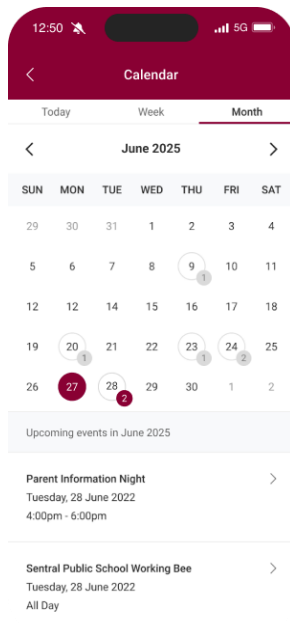
Looking at the key functionality, you will be able to quickly look and take action in the following areas:

- **Learning**
Powered by Toddle, it allows you to access your child's learning
- **Newsfeed**
Receive all the latest live news, information, events, etc
- **Absences**
Request future absences and receive absence notifications, with the ability to provide reasons for the absence
- **Calendar**
Keep up to date with all school events and key dates
- **Conferences**
Easy to book and arrange your children's parent/teacher conferences
- **Newsletters**
Instantly download the latest Newsletter, or any previous editions published
- **Key Information**
Access all school information, documents and links
- **Medical Information**
See your child's health information and/or update it easily to ensure ESF has the latest details on file
- **ESF Explore**
One simple click to connect you to ESF Explore website

Looking at each one in turn, this is what they will look like:

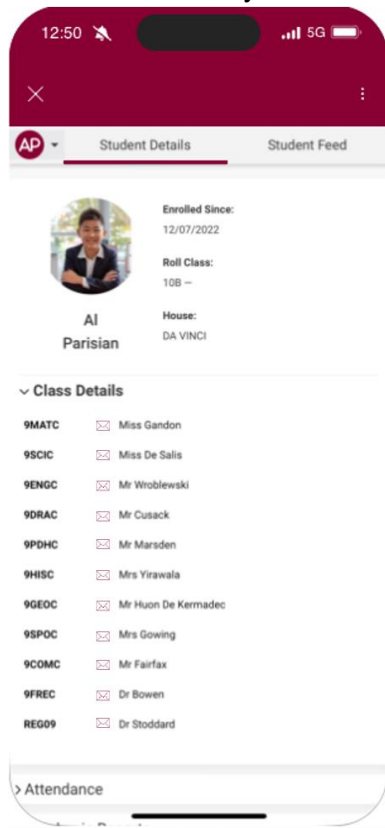
Calendar

- View and track your child's activities, events, classes and timetables effortlessly via the Calendar on the ESF Hub



Class Details

- View your child's profile and details
- There are many items you can view such as your child's class details, which provides you with an overview of the classes your child will attend
- Class Details also features the ability to make communication simpler with your child's teachers, by a click of a button you can email your child's class teacher



Absences

- Easy notifications for current absences
- Future Absences are made simple
 1. Select the child/children who are going to be absent
 2. Add the reason
 3. Enter the date/dates of absence
 4. Enter a comment
 5. Press send
- Future absences can be scheduled ahead of time
- All future absences that are approved will come through as a notification via the ESF Hub

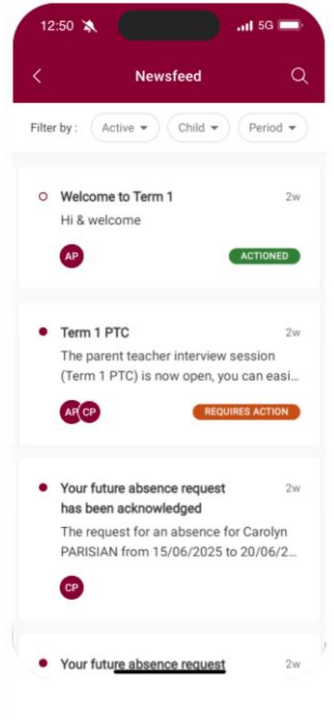

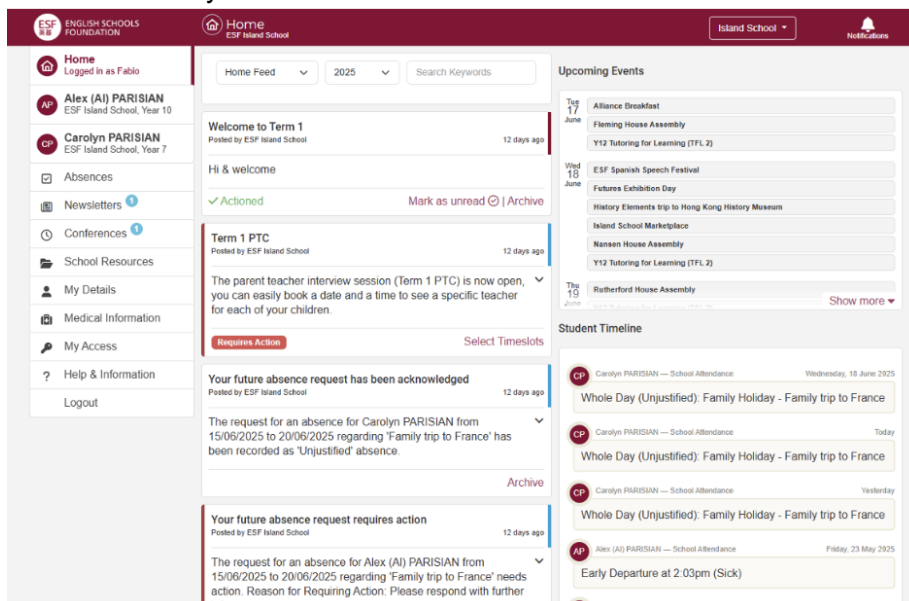


Parent Portal (desktop version)



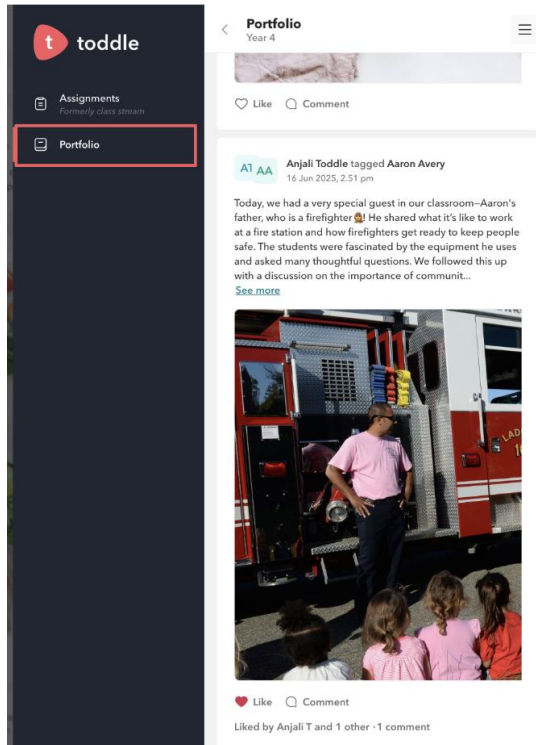

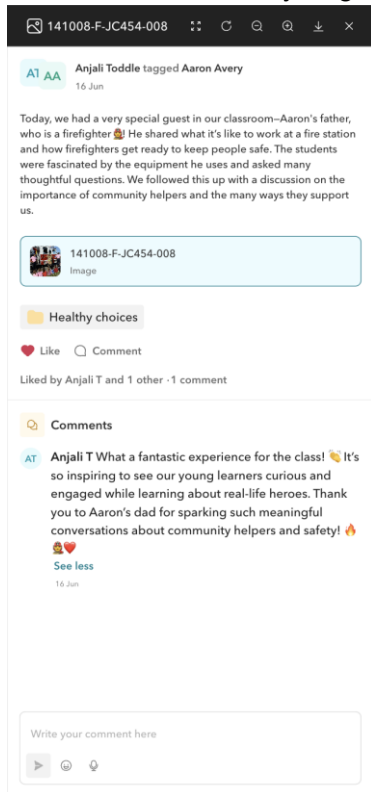
